Currently, he is a post-Doctoral researcher (Assegnista di Ricerca) in the department of Biomolecular and Health sciences at the University of Turin. His research is focused on the integration of computational techniques with Life Science and Medicinal Chemistry approaches. At present, he is responsible for two main research lines: a) assessing the druggability of genetic, rare neurodegenerative diseases, and b) the development of innovative degrader drugs through computational approaches.
